THE RANGE COMMANDS

While the PA Range Officer Guides for the ISSF pistol events use the same range commands as used at an international championship competition, at an international events such as ISSF World Cups and the Olympics there will be a commentator giving a running account of the event for the media.

PA ‘AUSTRALIAN’ CONDITIONS

PA recognises that not all venues holding PA ISSF events will be able to meet the target requirements (e.g. electronic targets) as per the ISSF rules. To this end, PA has the PA ‘Australian’ conditions to enable ISSF pistol events to be conducted on these ranges.

In particular the PA ‘Australian’ conditions cover:

- 50m Pistol on paper targets,
- ISSF Finals on paper target systems,
- Dimensions of occluders and side-blinders is not applied,
- Some latitude is allowed for support for tennis elbow ([more on this>](#)),
